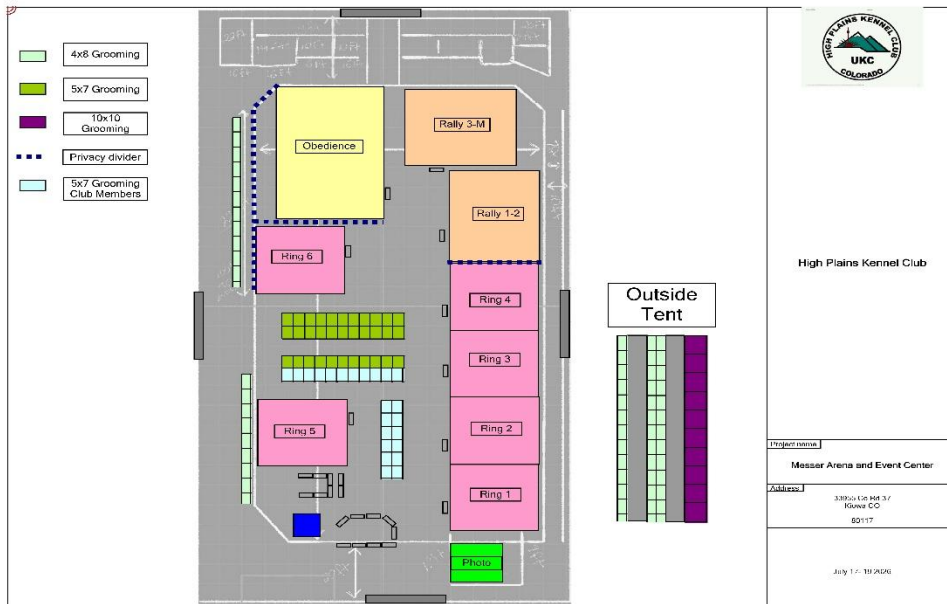
We are offering SPOT testing again this event. The tests will take place between Show 1 and Show 2 or after show 2 on both Friday July 17th, and Saturday July 18th.

There will be 2 licensed SPOT judges testing during the event.

There will be a sign-up sheet at the registration table. It is \$25 per test and is paid at the registration table (cash preferred).

When you sign up, take a SPOT evaluation form and have it filled out and ready when you take your test.

There are also SPOT Participant handbooks available if you wish to take one.



This is the layout of the show arena. Pink are conformation rings, orange are rally rings, and yellow obedience ring. There is the registration table by ring 5 and the horseshoe table is raffle. Most of the grooming is in the outside tent. Exhibitors are **REQUIRED** to clean up all hair, trash, and debris from their grooming area. The green boxes are limited exhibitor grooming. The light blue boxes are reserved for club member grooming.

There is no electricity available, so plan accordingly.

There is **no water on the site**, bring water for you and your dogs.

NO X-PENS ARE ALLOWED.

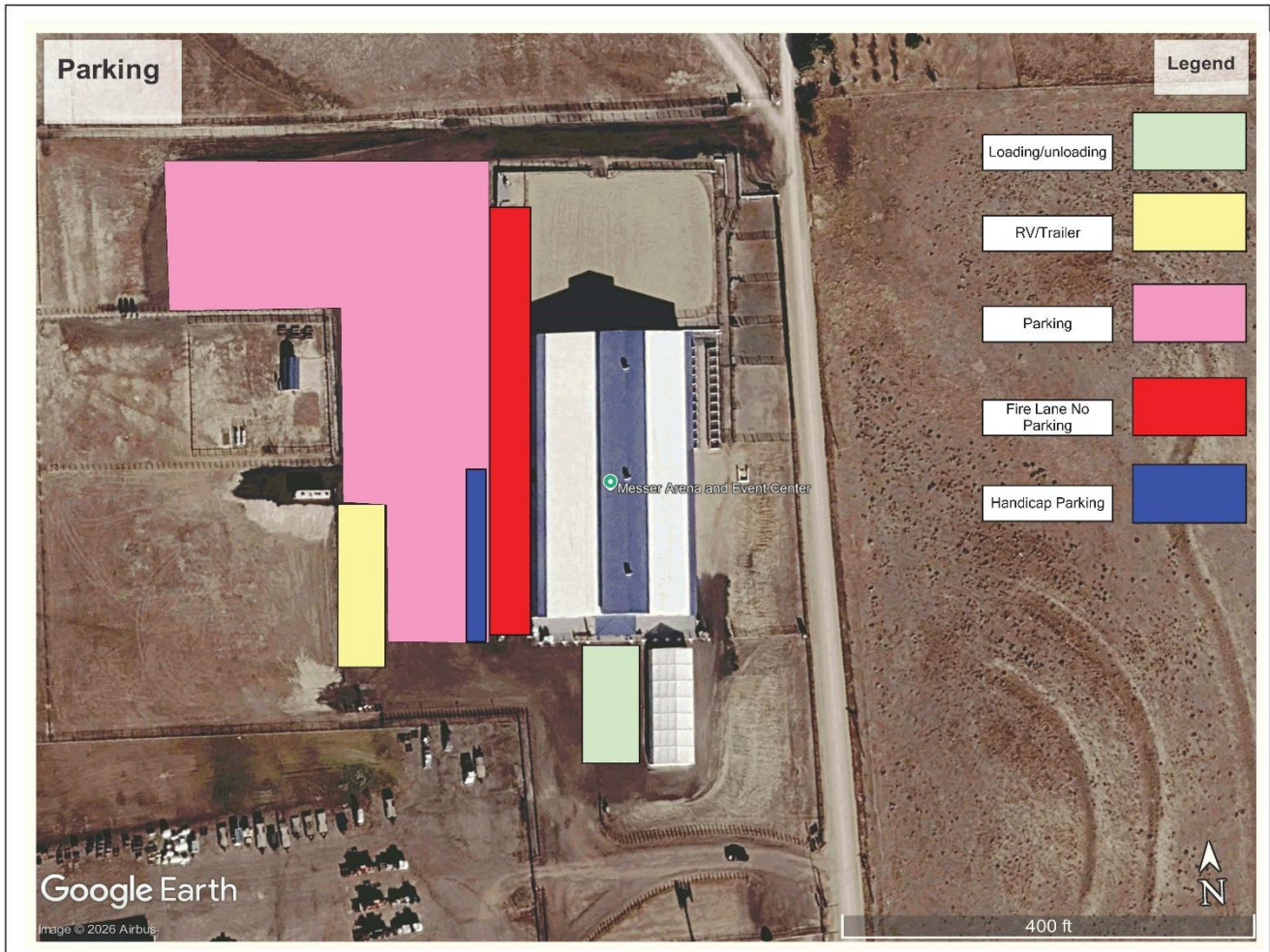
Crating space will be available on a first come, first-serve basis.

Set ups must be in the designated areas in the show arena or in the big tent on the south side of the building.

There is VERY limited grooming inside the show building
All dogs at the show site must be on non-flexi leads or in a crate.

DON'T FORGET to BRING YOUR OWN CHAIR, Battery Fans (if needed) and WATER for you and your dog!

This is the building and parking and grooming tent. Note that the light green area by the tent is 15-minute loading and unloading only. The tent doors are on the side by the loading area. ALL vehicles must be moved from this side of the building to the pink parking area. The blue section along the wall is handicap parking and MUST display a handicap placard or license plate.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS:

This event is being hosted by the High Plains Kennel Club and is a United Kennel Club (UKC) licensed event with conformation shows and obedience and rally trials. All UKC rules and regulations will apply.

Entries to all UKC events for both licensed and non-licensed classes must be submitted using the most current official UKC forms. Please use the forms downloaded from UKCDogs.com or highplainskennelclub.org for the Performance entry form, Conformation entry form, and/or Junior entry form. There are links for all 3 entry forms for our event on the UKCDogs.com website, at the bottom of our show information and at the bottom of the event listing for our event on the UKC events page.

Exhibitors, through their submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the UKC rules and regulations. These include the contents of UKC Conformation Rulebook, Official UKC Rules For All-Breed Events & Misconduct, Official UKC Junior Rulebook, Official UKC Obedience Rulebook, and Official Rally Obedience Rulebook. For further information on the UKC rules and regulations, please refer to the UKC website, www.ukcdogs.com.

Dogs must be registered with the UKC to enter and have a permanent registration number, valid Temporary Listing (TL) or a Limited Privilege (LP) number as of the day of the event. (Novice puppy does not need to have a UKC number.)

The use of alcohol or illegal drugs at a UKC event is prohibited. Violators may be excused from the ring by the judge and from the show or event grounds by the Event Committee or any officer of the host club.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and maintaining a clean crating and/or grooming area. Any exhibitor seen not cleaning up after their dog by a club member will be asked to clean up or leave the show with no refund.

There shall be no refunds for entries except for a female in season entered in performance. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, weather, or acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this show, NO refund of entry fees will be made. NO substitutions are allowed. Should the show need to be cancelled due to public health mandates, NO refunds will be given.

Parents or guardians are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them always supervised and in control for their own safety.

High Plains Kennel Club will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result be by accident or another cause.

Per UKC Rules & Regulations: MISCONDUCT & DISCIPLINE FOR UKC® ALL-BREED EVENTS Category 1. Wrongdoing during or associated with a UKC Licensed event. This may include but is not limited to: abuse of hotel rooms by dogs or persons attending the events; and any other UKC event rule infraction.
